2 Past Simple or Present Perfect



PAST SIMPLE

 We use the past simple when we are talking about a finished time in the past:

Tom lost his keys yesterday
Five years ago I went to France
I ate a lot of sweets when I was young
He left the building a few minutes ago

 We also use it for actions that are not connected with the present:

The Chinese **invented** printing Shakespeare **wrote** Hamlet

 We use the past simple to ask or say "when" something happened:

When did it start raining?
When did you first meet each other?

PRESENT PERFECT

 We use the present perfect when it tells us about something in the present:

John **has lost** his keys

He hasn't got his keys now

 We also use it with a period of time that continues to the present:

I have lived here for 15 years
I've smoked 20 cigarettes today

• We use the present perfect with **non-specific times**:

I've been there before I've already eaten lunch He has just left

• We also use it to ask or say "how long" something has happened :

How long have you lived in Gijon? How long has he known you?
